### **Read Mark 11:1-11**

Compare Matthew 21:1-11, Luke 19:28-40 and John 12:12-19. What is unique to Mark's account?

Throughout the book of Mark, Jesus has sought to quiet the crowd and keep his identity somewhat hidden. Why do you think this situation is so different?

Read Zechariah 9:9. What are some things this imagery suggests about the type of leader Jesus is?

The disciples that Jesus sent to fetch the donkey had to step out in faith that what Jesus told them would happen. In our own lives, how do we know when we're acting in faith on a word from God vs. listening to our own voices?

Do you think it's easier to trust Jesus with something valuable to us or something that feels shameful or unusable? Is there anything you're wrestling with handing over to him right now?
