In the sermon, the distinction was made between what God says about us and what God asks about us. List some things (from the sermon or otherwise) that you see God as saying are universal about humanity.

Read the story of the Ethiopian Eunuch in Acts 8:26-40. How does this story shape your thoughts around the gospel and who it is for?
