## **Read Acts 2:1-41**

What is the earliest impression you recall having of the Holy Spirit? In your mind, what do you associate with the work of the Holy Spirit?

Based on the Pentecost story in Acts 2, the sermon said that "The Holy Spirit speaks your language." Can you think of a time and way that God demonstrated he was speaking your language?

In John 16:7, Jesus told his disciples it was actually better for him to leave and send the Holy Spirit. In what ways is having the Spirit an advantage over having the physical Jesus with us?

The spectacles of wind, fire and speaking in foreign languages were attention grabbing, but they were not the primary working of the Spirit in this story. What are some examples of what he was doing that are maybe less dramatic but equally powerful?

The list of places Luke gives of where people had come from in Acts 2 radiates in all directions around Jerusalem. The Holy Spirit was taking the gospel further all the time. When you take a 360 degree snapshot in your own life, where can you see the Spirit working in new places? Where would you like to see him?
